God has been so good to our church. The owner of the school we are using is a Hindu. How we ended using and renting this school is a miracle! As you can see we are using a class room for our church services. We are now seriously launching a project to buy a small piece of land for our church. On our 1st Harambee or fund raising we raised 52,000 Kenyan shillings (\$650). Sixty five percent of this amount came from Eldoret Grace Church members. Truly, we are moved on how they gave out from their poverty. Before this year ends we will have a big Harambee where we will be inviting many people. Quarter of an acre is costing seven to nine thousand dollars. It's a long way to its completion but we praised God for how He enabled our young and small congregation. Please pray with us.

On September 28 & 29, pastors, missionaries and church elders met for the first time to hold prayers in Nakuru Grace Bible Church. We spent 2 days praying for revival, unity, ministry needs, open doors, families, nations, supporters and numerical and spiritual growth of the work in Kenya. The immediate result was that nearly everyone committed to spend personal quality time with God. Every leader is excited to see what God is going to accomplish through His chosen leaders
