A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR SROUCH

“My dream was to be a lawyer because I wanted to help the people. I prayed to the Lord about this dream and I even asked him what are the things I can do if I were a lawyer. I was always interested in justice, peace and order and service to the people but I never thought of becoming a pastor. Since 2005, after I became a Christian, I have been involved in some sort of ministry in my province until I joined TCM last 2007. But there was one situation that called my attention and helped me think about my purpose. One day I brought my student to a hospital because his knee needed to be operated, I saw many patients there and most of them were hopeless. I asked myself about what these people really need. As I pondered, their need is not “law”—it is salvation that they need. Can the law save them from death? No, only God can save them from death. On 20 December 2011 I decided to become a pastor. I want to offer my life to the Lord because He sacrificed himself because of my sins. He gives me grace. I learned to obey Him and now I am giving my life back to Him.”

PERSONAL BACKGROUND

Mr. Srouch Sorn is a Cambodian national and first Grace member who decided to serve God full time under Things to Come Mission. He is a 25 year old law graduate from the top law school of Cambodia. He has lived in the TCM dormitory since 2007 and is a very active member of Phnom Penh Grace Gospel Church of Christ. During his stay in the dormitory under the leadership of Pastor Ariel Mahilum, Srouch has studied Bible lessons and served in various ministries in the church and ministry outreach. His decision to serve God is an amazing testimony of God’s faithfulness and power to change lives. He will continue to serve his internship under Ariel Mahilum’s guidance and will work alongside TCM missionaries in bringing people to Christ.
