*Happy 33<sup>rd</sup> Wedding Anniversary!*



Dear Beloved Brethren in the Lord,

Greetings from Southern Brazil through Christ's precious Name! Thank you once again for your continued prayers and financial support for the Ministry here in Brazil. Doubts and discouragement are sometimes hindrances in the advancement of the Ministry, but trusting in God is the only remedy: *Take a step forward through the leading of the Holy Spirit and DO the Ministry.* It is one of Nene's lessons for the Women's Prayer Meeting every Tuesday afternoon.

**ACCIDENT!** "We just arrived 5AM on 19th—no sleep the whole night. I preached at Carlos Schmidt's church in Timbo and saw the next part of their construction. But then we had a car accident at 11:30PM, at the boundary between Sta. Catarina and Paraná. It was dark, no cellphone signals, in the midst of nowhere. People stopped to try to help us but no signals to call for towing. Two tires had exploded, and to avoid invading the double lane road, I tried to hold the steering wheel in the middle of the road—until we hit concrete about a foot high—with a big impact that pushed the engine up almost on the hood. The damage is really extensive, don't know when it will be fixed up, but praise the Lord Nene and I are OK with no injury except I am still trembling from the shock with no appetite. Imagine how the Lord protected us and it was our 33<sup>rd</sup> wedding anniversary! He also provided a Christian family who sacrificed to stay with us the whole night because they said that place was risky, lots of robbery, etc."

When we moved down here to the seacoast over a year ago, we lost lots of material things necessary for our living. Thank the Lord for your prayers and support as we slowly recover some of the things we need. There is a saying: "God will never leave you empty. He will replace everything you've lost. If He asks you to put something down, it is because He wants you to pick up something greater."

We continue helping in various types of Ministry here at the seacoast area at a small church in Guapé. Last November we celebrated our first Church Anniversary with almost 100 people attending and I (Gomer) preached on Psalm 116: "*What shall we render unto the LORD for all his benefits towards us.*" It was a nice meeting and someone even donated 10 kilos of cake! Also November 29 Nene led a Women's Fellowship here in the Guapé church where 40 women attended, including women from the grace churches around. Nene shared from the Word of God about how Women can do lots of things in the Ministry. Half of them rededicated their lives to help in the Ministry.

The end of December we held our church service to welcome the New Year 2012 and about 60 people attended, the majority were from among our neighbors who heard the Word of God.

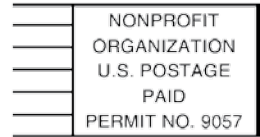
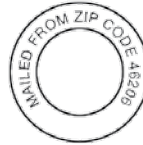

- 4.) **PRAY** for the worldwide economic crisis which also reaches here in Brazil. The US\$ is devaluating and gas is high at \$6.50-\$7 a gallon.
- 5.) **PRAY** for our transportation needs to be figured out and paid for. Thanks.
