Dear Friends and Supporters,

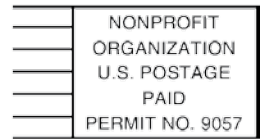
Six years ago we started our missionary work in Uganda. By God's grace we accomplished Bible Studies, Bible Teacher's Class, training for young men and women for Christ, and childrens' ministries. Three pastors are qualified to teach and preach the gospel according to the revelation of the mystery. Soon other youth will be responsible in proclaiming the message of the grace of God.

Our place of worship in Kerombi-Luzira has changed many times from a tent to papyrus to galvanized iron then to stronger bricks. But it was built on rented land because we really needed a church building for people to worship. We did not expect our landlord will sell the land. It's our big challenge this year. TCM gave \$5000 to help purchase the land. Now we need ten to twelve thousand more. Our members will try to raise an amount to help too. We trust the Lord for His provision to purchase this land where our church stands. We have many children in Luzira church. We can't imagine if they're no longer in our Sunday School. There are active members in our choir and also Sunday School teachers. Many youth attend Luzira church and if we cannot buy the land, then this congregation will not be there anymore. We come to Luzira once a month as Pastor Philip, the church board and our youth are the ones responsible for church activities.



Our worship services in Muyenga began in February 2011. We set up a tent for use for our activities such as Bible studies, training Bible teachers, prayer meetings, etc. The last week of November we started building the church until 24th December. We finished up to the strong foundation as our funds allowed us up to this point as Phase 1. 2012 is another great challenge for us. Phase 2 is cement flooring and columns for pillars. Pastor Aman worked hard to minimize the expenses, but we're forced to stop when funds got finished. Pastor Aman and two Filipinos volunteered to help us on this project. Thank God for them. Phase 3 is roofing until we finish the whole project. Tentative budget for Phase 2 is \$7000 and Phase 3 around \$13000. Then we can view it as an attractive church building. We're excited to see the finished church building in Bukasa-Muyenga. People come to our tent church, but when it rains, we have a big problem because even if we move, we still experience the rain hitting us.

Thank you for giving to the Lord, for I am a life that was changed... Thank you for giving to the Lord, you gave and another man stood before you and said, 'Remember the time a missionary came to your church. His pictures made you cry... You didn't have much money, but you gave it anyway. Jesus took the gift you gave, that's why I'm here today.' One by one they came, as far as eye could see... each life somehow touched by your generosity. Little things that you have done, sacrifice made unnoticed on the earth, in heaven now proclaim... I know up in heaven you're not supposed to cry, but I am almost sure there were tears in your eyes. As Jesus Christ took your hand and you stood before the Lord, He said, 'My child, look around you, and great is your reward. I am so glad you gave.'
